Dramatic Introductions

A dramatic introduction has some special features:

- It has action.
- It happens *on one day*.
- It has two paragraphs.
- ▶ The first paragraph tells a *very short story* about what happened during one day.
- ▶ The second paragraph explains how the story is connected to your topic. The last sentence is usually your *thesis statement*.
