Student A

 - 3. Tell Student B, "We're at a party at your uncle's house. I'm an older man. We're standing near each other."
 - 4. Tell Student B, "We're at a park. I'm a child sitting next to you on a park bench."
 - 5. Tell Student B, "We're at a meeting for new foreign students. Before the meeting starts, you see me standing alone. I look lonely."
 - 6. Tell Student B, "We're in the waiting room of a doctor's office. I'm just sitting here. I look worried."
